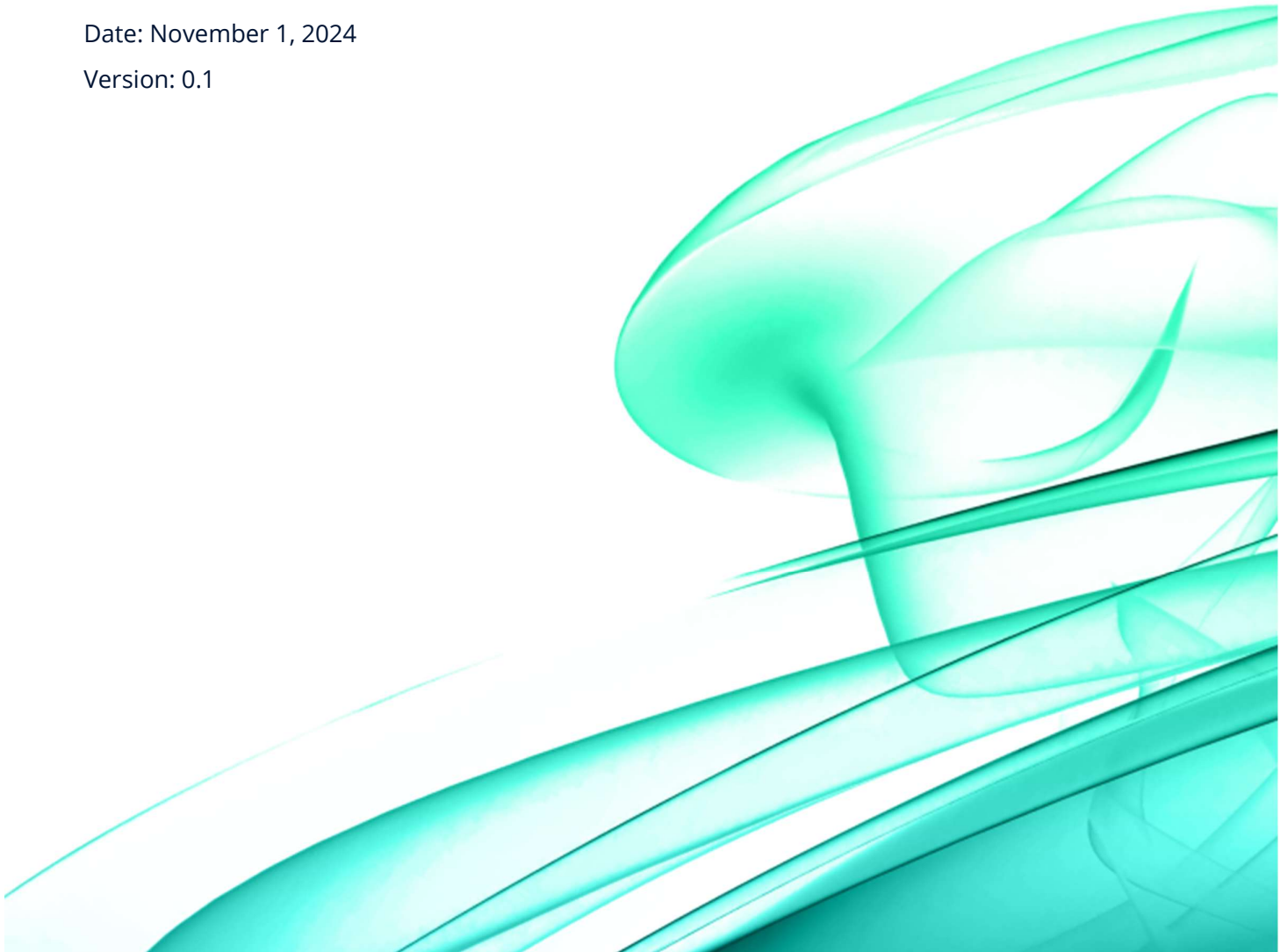

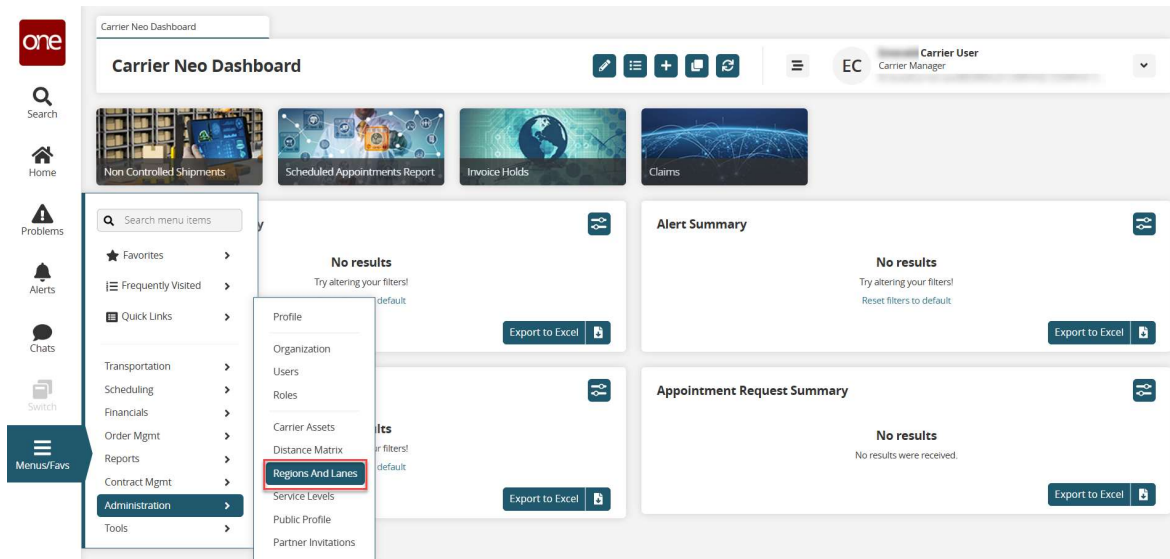


Introduction

This document provides a quick guide explaining how to create Regions, Lanes and Zones to manage the transportation in One Network Enterprises, a Blue Yonder company (ONE).

Regions are typically described as geographical parameters defining the transport work. A Lane includes the definition as transporting from a point or are to another point within the same Region. A Zone is often used to define the distance that is travelled along a Lane.

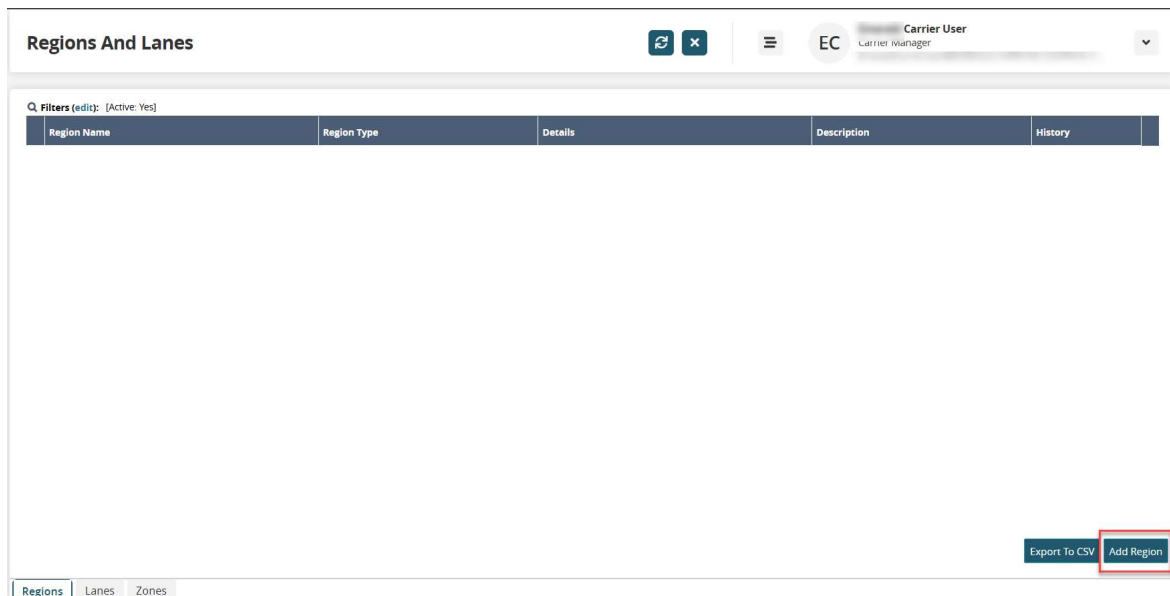
1. Click **Menus/Favs > Administration > Regions and Lanes**.

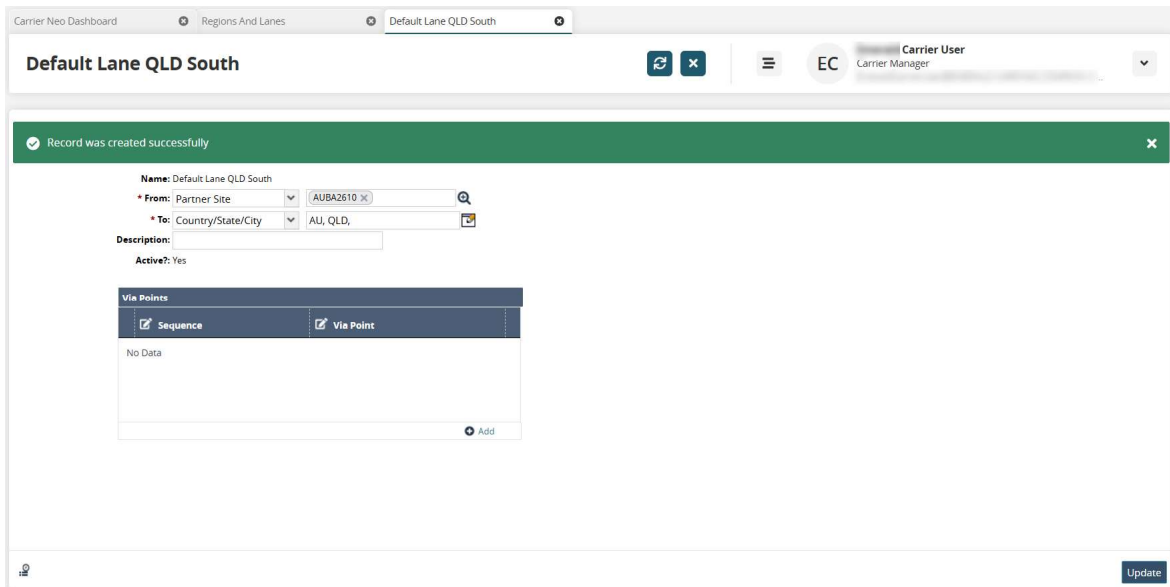
