



Shipment Communication Process


- Confirmation of the Appointment
- Dispatch batching file / Order file

Transport Execution

- Carriers can follow suggestions to build Movements or fulfill their own plan and submit completed movements to the assigned truck/driver
- Driver will be able to receive notifications via the mobile app and provide updates or upload documents during the run

Reporting and Analytics

- Enhanced view of Shipment status
- Measure on-time, in-full performance
- Enable automated alerting services on orders, forecasts, shipments and problems that require action.


